Bundaberg Region contains a host of fun and challenging areas for the 4WD enthusiast.

PARKS AND FORESTS

The **Kinkuna National Park** area has tracks for both beginners and veterans on track and sand. At **Woodgate** and **Burrum Point** there are many good rough tracks and beach access.

The **Watalgan State Forest** south of Rosedale has some challenging rocky tracks meandering around and over some decent sized hills.

Goodnight Scrub National Park boasts One Tree Hill lookout, the route to which is a great opportunity for rugged 4WD enthusiasts. There are many more parks in the region with 4WD access including **Deepwater National Park**, **Mt Walsh National Park**, **Littabella National Park** and **Auburn River National Park**.

Eurimbula National Park is accessible from Round Hill Road 19kms from Agnes Water. There is 4WD access through the national park to Bustard Camp Ground or Middle Creek Camp Ground.





BEACH DRIVING

At **Moore Park Beach** there is 4WD access at the northern 10kms of beach as far as the mouth of the Kolan River. Approximately 50kms north of Bundaberg, **Norval Park Beach** offers 20kms of beach four wheel driving along the southern section towards Miara. Approximately 70kms north of Bundaberg, **Rules Beach** has several tracks suitable for four wheel driving, eventually emerging at Agnes Water.
